A Year of Miracles

"How do I even begin to express the amazing privilege of having a front row seat in watching God at work? How do I recount in a nutshell the numerous untold stories of changed lives over this past year? How do I begin to describe this sacred space of an ultrasound room?

A Father's Heart Softened

When Elise came to our Centereach office with her boyfriend, Aaron, he thought he was bringing her to have an abortion. He was trying to convince her to end this pregnancy, then he would marry her 'without shame'. Elise's struggle was with her culture, her religion...how could it be shameful to be pregnant before marriage, but not shameful to end the life of a child? She wrestled with these thoughts for days prior, through a tearful phone call to us, wanting to have this baby without facing judgement. She wanted to be a mom. Aaron agreed to come in for the ultrasound. Elise was tearful as Aaron wore an angry and stoic countenance, but when he looked at the screen and saw his baby, he saw the heartbeat— and a visible change came over him. The palpable anger was gone. As Aaron studied the printed ultrasound picture in his hand, a quiet smile and a nod of the head agreeing that he was a father were seen. He had changed his mind.

A Safe Space

Gina had a negative pregnancy test result. However, the true reason God brought her to Soundview was quickly revealed. She was seeking a safe space...a listening ear. As Gina unpacked the trauma and abuse in her life, we shared tears. We shared hugs. We prayed. I shared with her about the God who dearly loves her. She met with a social worker where resources and hope were offered, and came face to face with truth, compassion, and her Savior. She chose Jesus! The healing begins.

'That's My Grandchild...'

It was by God's grace that Katherine was referred to Soundview by her high school teacher. She was young and scared. Katherine wasn't what we would consider 'abortion determined,' however, her mother was, on behalf of her daughter. Full of anger and disappointment, her mom was clear, 'We are not doing this! You are not having a baby!' And then time stopped as she watched the ultrasound, the heartbeat of the precious life playing before her in real time. There was silence. Silent prayer. Watching the screen Katherine's mother somberly whispered, 'That's my grandchild'...the story changed. Hope began. Life was chosen.

A New Family Formed

Tanya came in one morning with abortion on her mind. She was in a long distance relationship with Wes, the father of the baby. During the ultrasound we discovered Tanya was much further along in pregnancy than she expected, well into the second trimester. She was wrestling with the stressful idea of single parenting, yet feeling like God protected this baby for a reason. Wes saw the picture of his baby. We discussed options together with Wes over ZOOM, giving he and Tanya time and space with the world shut out in this quiet peaceful spot—a holy hush. 'Baby, you know what we need to do,' he said. 'I know,' she replied. Both in tears, both sobbing, choosing to parent, making plans for her to move...seeing life and embracing it. A new life chosen. A new family formed. Jesus at work right before my eyes in this office.

Who but God knows the power of a moment, a chance to pause. The power of a listening ear. The power of a compassionate touch, a hug. The power of kindness in a cruel world. The power of time and space. The power of an ultrasound. The power of whispered prayers and audible ones too. The power of Hope offered. The power of Jesus to heal hearts and save lives.

How can we not praise Him for one incredible year? Surely, the presence of the Lord is in this place."

Lives Transformed

- 62% of all women served were at high risk for abortion, stating their initial pregnancy intentions were abortion or undecided, before experiencing our care.
- 20+ young women enrolled in our discipleship parenting program.
- We celebrated our 9th successful Abortion Pill Reversal birth
- 9 individuals received baby shower celebrations, each including \$500 - \$1000 worth of baby gifts and essentials.
- 17 women were counseled through reproductive loss care including abortion recovery and miscarriage care.


In the News


On Wednesday, April 24th, 2024, Soundview received an official notice of litigation from New York State Attorney General, Letitia James, for allegedly "misleading statements or omissions in the advertising of the Abortion Pill Reversal protocol." Although accusations were false, the letter we received did not come as a surprise to our team as we witness the extreme proabortion legislative actions of New York State and blatant disregard for the unborn. Represented pro bono by The Thomas More Society, a non-profit national public interest law firm defending life, family, and freedom, we responded confidently. On April 30, Thomas More Society attorneys filed a verified complaint in the Supreme Court of New York against James, outlining how her threatened prosecution and intimidation of pregnancy help organizations violates the First and Fourteenth Amendments of the United States Constitution, the New York State Constitution, and state civil rights law. Although the outcome of this case is still pending, we are trusting God for his continued protection and provision in this matter.
